Interchange

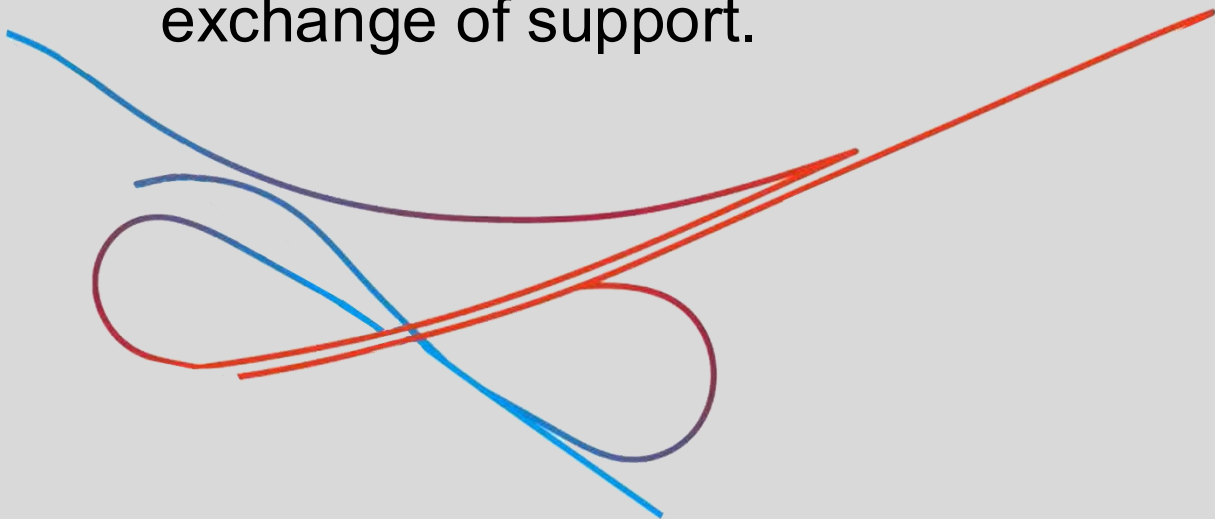
Building links between first and final year students
